

COMPLETE REGULATIONS

ARTICLE 1: ORGANIZING ASSOCIATION

The association Knokke Hippique VZW, non-profit association under Belgian law, with registered office at Hazegrasstraat 141, 8300 Knokke-Heist, Belgium 1861 (hereinafter "the Organizing Association"), organizes a competition titled "WIN a VIP session during Knokke Hippique 2018" in Belgium (hereinafter "the Contest").

The Contest runs from May 20, 2018 to June 26, 2018.

ARTICLE 2: CONDITIONS WITH REGARD TO THE PARTICIPANTS IN THE CONTEST

2.1. The Competition is open to all adults or all minors with the permission of one of the parents or legal representatives (hereinafter "the Participant").

2.2. Are expressly excluded from the Contest, all employees, staff members of the companies or associations that are part of the group of the Organizing Association, as well as their direct family members. This exclusion also concerns all persons who, directly or indirectly, contributed to the design, organization, realization and / or management of the Competition, as well as their direct family members.

If necessary, an identity card may be requested by the Organizing Association.

ARTICLE 3: VALIDITY TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PARTICIPATION

By participating, the Participants grant permission for all controls regarding their identity.

The Participants commit to filling in the correct information on the online entry form. If necessary, they agree to transfer supporting documents to the Organizing Association.

ARTICLE 4: PROCESS OF THE CONTEST

To compete, the Participant must proceed to the following website: <http://knokkehippique.com/> where he or she should fill out the received code, stated on the coupon he or she received during the activation in Knokke-Heist.

Afterwards, the Participant must complete two questions. The Participant who answered the two questions correctly (or the one who comes closest to the correct answer) is the winner of the Contest (hereafter "the Winner").

ARTICLE 5: PRIZE

ARTICLE 7: COMPLAINTS

And this within a period of maximum one month after the closing date of the Competition, i.e. at the latest on July 26, 2018. No complaint will be processed after this date.

The Prize can in no case be exchanged for the value in cash or at another prize.

ARTICLE 8: LIABILITY

The Organizing Association can under no circumstances be held directly or indirectly liable in the following cases:

- in case of disruption of the internet or the website, for any reason whatsoever;
- in the case of a mail item to an incorrect address as a result of negligence on the part of the Winner;
- in the case of unreadable, crossed-out or incomplete correspondence, or correspondence with incorrect or incorrect information and / or non-compliance with the conditions stated in these Regulations;
- in case of any problem with the Prize and in case of accident when using the Prize.

In general, the Organizing Association can not be held responsible for any fact that can not be attributed to it, and not in case of force majeure, as a result of which the Competition could be disturbed, altered or canceled.

In case of force majeure, in accordance with the law and the case law, the Organizing Association can not be held responsible. Force majeure is understood in particular within the meaning of these Regulations: wars, riots, strikes, fire, floods, natural disasters, the blocking of the transport and supply means of the telecommunication networks, legal and regulatory provisions that impose restrictions on the object of these Regulations, as well as the cases mentioned in the jurisprudence and all other cases that occur outside the express wish of the Organizing Association and that prevent the normal execution of the Competition. All cases not provided for by the Regulations will be assessed by the Organizing Association, no appeal is possible against its decisions.

ARTICLE 9: CONSULTATION AND CHANGES TO THIS REGULATION

The Organizing Association reserves the right to amend all or part of the provisions of these complete Regulations at any time, without prior notification or information to the Participants, in particular in case of technical, legal or jurisprudence developments or the introduction of new conditions.

The Organizing Association reserves the right to shorten, extend or cancel this Competition if circumstances require so, without being held responsible. The conditions of the Contest as well as the prize offered to the winner can not give rise to objections of any nature whatsoever.

Each amendment is the subject of an additional provision and is sent free of charge to anyone who requests a regulation in writing in accordance with the provisions of article 10.

Every change is informed in advance via the appropriate means. The additional provisions and amendments to these Rules may be published during the Competition in order to shorten, extend, postpone or change the conditions.

In any case neither the Regulations nor the offered prize can give rise to complaints of any kind.

No requests for information (written, telephone or oral) concerning the interpretation or application of the Regulations will be addressed.

The Organizing Association reserves the right to appeal in any way whatsoever upon any attempt to circumvent these Rules and in particular in the event of the transmission of incorrect information.

ARTICLE 10: ACCEPTANCE OF THE RULES

The Participation in the Contest implies the acceptance by the Participant of the complete Rules.
